<p>Pancake Recipe</p> <p>3 Pour the milk into the bowl.</p> 	<p>Pancake Recipe</p> <p>4 Beat together with a whisk.</p> 	<p>Pancake Recipe</p> <p>5 Cook mixture in a frying pan.</p>

Cloud Dough Recipe

You only need 3 ingredients for this. Cornflour, baby lotion and food colouring.

Mix 2 cups of cornflour and 1 cup of baby lotion, add in a few drops of food colouring.

You can make a few different colours of the cloud dough. Happy experimenting



How to make DIY chalk paint

What you need:

1 cup of Cornflour

1 cup of warm water

Food colouring or paint

Empty spray bottle(s)

What to do:

- In a large bowl mix together 1 cup of cornflour and 1 cup of water until well mixed.
- Divide the mixture into as many spray bottles you have.
- Add the food colouring or paint into the bottles, close up the bottles and shake until all the mixture has mixed together.
- You can now spray your chalk paint outside of paper or directly onto the ground. Ask an adult if it's ok to spray outside first.
